Summary:

The Centre for International Studies (CEI-Iscte) of Iscte – University Institute of Lisbon is accepting applications for 1 (one) Research Fellowship for a PhD Student, in the area of International Studies or similar, aligned with the CEI-Iscte strategic plan, under the FCT 'Regulamento de Bolsas de Investigação' (RBI) and the 'Estatuto do Bolseiro de Investigação' (EBI).

The grant will be funded by the Fundação para a Ciência e a Tecnologia (FCT) under the framework of the Programmatic Pluriannual Funding, with the reference UIDP/03122/2020.

1. SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION

The call is open from 17 to 28 June 2024 (11.59 p.m. Lisbon time).

Applications and supporting documents must be submitted to Iscte – University Institute of Lisbon Recruitment platform: <https://recrutamento.iscte-iul.pt/jobs>.

Each candidate may submit only one application, under penalty of cancellation of all applications submitted.

False statements or plagiarism submitted by the candidates will lead to the cancellation of the application, without prejudice to the adoption of other sanctioning measures.

2. TYPE AND DURATION OF THE GRANT

In accordance with numbers 1 and 2 of Article 6 of the FCT Research Grant Regulation, the Research Grant (BI) is intended for the conduction of R&D activities by students enrolled in a doctoral programme, aimed at consolidating their scientific training through the development of research and that leads to the award of the respective academic degree, integrated or not in R&D projects, or for the conduct of R&D activities by master students who

are enrolled in courses that do not confer an academic degree integrated in the educational project of Iscte.

The grant will have a duration of 5 months, starting in August 2024. The grant contract may be renewed until the end of the programmatic project (UIDP/03122/2020) of CEI-Iscte.

3. WORK PLAN AND SCIENTIFIC ORIENTATION OF THE FELLOWSHIP

Development of scientific research and support to the implementation of the CEI-Iscte strategic project, across its research groups: Global Politics and Security; Democracy, Activism, and Citizenship; and Sustainable Societies.

The activities include: strengthening the external dissemination of CEI-Iscte strategic project, the organisation of events associated with the project, including seminars and conferences, as well as supporting CEI-Iscte publications.

The work will be carried out at the Centre for International Studies of the Iscte - University Institute of Lisbon, under the scientific supervision of Professor Ana Mónica Fonseca and Professor Giulia Daniele.

4. ADMISSIBILITY

4.1. Requirements for Admissibility of the candidates

The following are eligible to apply to this call for proposals

- National citizens or citizens from other Member States of the European Union;
- Non-EU citizens;
- Stateless persons;
- Citizens benefiting from the status of political refugee.

To apply for a PhD Research Fellowship, it is necessary:

- Hold a degree or master's degree in the areas of International Studies, Social Sciences, and related fields;
- Be enrolled in a doctoral programme or in a course integrated within Iscte's educational project;
- Demonstrate research experience in International Studies' area;

- Proven experience in editorial assistance to scientific publications;
- Proven experience in organising events;
- Excellent written and oral expression skills, including English;
- Solid computer skills;
- Do not hold a PhD degree.

4.2. Requirements for Admissibility of the application

The following documents must be annexed to the application, otherwise, admission to the competition will be refused:

- Curriculum Vitae of the candidate;
- Certificates of the academic degrees held, specifying the final classification and, if possible, the classifications obtained in all the courses taken, or, alternatively, a declaration of honour from the candidate stating that he/she has concluded the Bachelor or Master's degree by the end of the application deadline; More information: <https://www.dges.gov.pt/pt/pagina/reconhecimento?plid=374>
- Motivation Letter, with plan for collaboration with CEI-Iscte;
- Proof of enrolment in a doctoral programme or in non-degree courses included in Iscte's educational project;
- Other documents considered relevant (optional)
- Letters of recommendation (optional, maximum 2).

The application and all associated documents, including letters of motivation and recommendation, may be written in Portuguese or English.

5. EVALUATION CRITERIA

The selection methods to be used will be as follows:

- Curriculum evaluation - 40%.
- Previous proven experience in an academic work environment - 40%.
- Evaluation of writing skills and motivation letter - 10%.
- Proficiency in English and knowledge of language(s) - 10%.

If the jury considers it necessary, the best classified candidates may, in a second phase, be invited for an interview. In this second phase, the final classification will be obtained by weighting 60% of the classification from the first phase and 40% from the interview. If the jury considers that an interview is not necessary to complement the assessment of the candidates, the assessment of criteria A., B., C. and D. will have a final weighting of 100 per cent.

6. EVALUATION

The evaluation panel of the applications is composed of the following elements:

- President of the Jury - Doctor Ana Mónica Fonseca, Assistant Professor at Iscte – University Institute of Lisbon (Iscte)
- Full member - Doctor Giulia Daniele, Assistant Professor at Iscte;
- Full member - Doctor Pedro Seabra, Assistant Professor at Iscte;
- Substitute Member – Doctor Ana Lúcia Sá, Assistant Professor at Iscte.

The evaluation panel shall evaluate the applications in accordance with the evaluation criteria set out in this Notice of Call for Proposals, weighting the assessment elements.

7. DISSEMINATION OF RESULTS

The results of the evaluation will be communicated via e-mail to the e-mail address used by the applicant to send the application/indicated in the application.

8. DEADLINES AND PROCEDURES FOR HEARINGS

After communication of the provisional list of the results of the evaluation, the candidates have a period of 10 working days to make their comments during a prior hearing of interested parties, under the terms of Article 121 and following the Administrative Procedure Code.

The final decision will be issued after the analysis of the statements presented during the prior hearing of interested parties.

9. FELLOWSHIP COMPONENTS

The fellowship holder shall receive a monthly maintenance allowance, in accordance with the table in Annex I of the RBI (<https://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/valores>), of 1 259,64€. The grant may also include other components, under the terms set out in Article 18 of the RBI and in the amounts set out in Annex II. Payments to the fellowship holder are made by bank transfer to the account identified by the person concerned.

All grant recipients shall be covered by personal accident insurance for research activities, supported by FCT.

All grant recipients who are not covered by any social protection scheme may exercise their right to social security by joining the voluntary social insurance scheme, under the terms of the Social Security Contributions Code, with Iscte paying the costs resulting from the contributions under the terms and within the limits set forth in article 10 of the EBI.

10. APPLICABLE LAWS AND REGULATIONS

11. REQUIREMENTS FOR THE GRANTING OF FELLOWSHIP

The research fellowship contract is signed directly with Iscte -University Institute of Lisbon (Iscte). The following documents must be submitted for contractualization purposes:

- a) Copy of the civil, tax and, when applicable, social security identification document(s) (the provision of these documents may be substituted, at the option of the applicant, by presentation in person at Iscte, which will keep the elements contained therein that are relevant to the validity and execution of the contract, including civil, tax and social security identification numbers, as well as the validity of the respective documents);
- b) Copy of the qualification certificates of the academic degrees held;

- c) Presentation of the foreign academic degree recognition register and conversion of the respective final classifications to the Portuguese classification scale, if applicable
- d) Document proving enrolment and registration in the Doctoral Programme as indicated in the present Notice
- e) Document proving compliance with the regime of exclusive dedication (draft statement will be made available).

The award of the grant is also subject to

- fulfilment of the requirements set out in this Announcement of the Call
- the result of the evaluation
- The non-existence of unjustified breach of duties by the grant recipient under a previous grant contract funded directly or indirectly by FCT;

Failure to submit any of the documents by the contractualization process within 6 months of the date of communication of the decision to award a conditional grant will result in the expiration of the grant and the termination of the process.
