The Ecoprise course equips learners with the skills and mindset to create regenerative and sustainable enterprises. It integrates four dimensions of sustainability—social, ecological, economic, and cultural — through cutting-edge topics such as permaculture ethics, ecovillage design, circular economy, digital and green transitions, and ecopreneurship.
